

**Advisory Boards/Commissions
That Fall or Have Fallen Outside of The Normal Appointment Process**

The following is a list of advisory boards/commissions that fall or have fallen outside of the normal appointment process. This means vacancies on these boards/commissions are not advertised by the County. The Board does not make nominations but is asked to approve the appointment of those nominated by the submitting entity and/or the BOCC chairman. These boards are governed by other governing entities, whose by-laws or applicable state statute requires an appointment by the BOCC. These boards do not operate under the advisory board rules of the County.

Town Planning Boards are governed by state statute 160A-362 Extraterritorial Representation. Appointments to these boards are made by the full board based on recommendations received from Town Boards of Commissioners.

Centralina Economic Development Commission – Appointments to this commission are made by the full board, traditionally, based on recommendations received from the BOCC chairman.

Charlotte/Mecklenburg Development Corporation (CMDC) – Appointments to this commission are made by the full board, traditionally, based on recommendations received from the BOCC chairman or the CMDC.

The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority (d.b.a. Carolinas HealthCare System) – Appointments are governed by state statute 131E-18, which authorizes the BOCC Chairman and the Mayor to appoint members directly, without Board or Council approval. Nominees are submitted to the Chairman for consideration by The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority (d.b.a. Carolinas HealthCare System).

Public Arts Commission – Appointments to this commission are made by the full Board, traditionally, based on recommendations received from the Public Arts Commission.

The following is a list of the outside Boards that the Chairman makes appointments to directly, either by assigning a fellow Commissioner or public representative to serve on the County's behalf. These are BOCC liaison appointments.
