Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and The United Association of Mobile Contract Cleaners invite you to attend an informational seminar on wash water runoff management.

All of the storm drains in Charlotte-Mecklenburg flow directly to lakes and streams. Wash water from power washing and vehicle detailing is a pollution problem because many metals and automotive fluids are washed off along with soapy water. Even biodegradable soap can be toxic to aquatic habitats.

Robert Hinderliter, environmental consultant with the United Association of Mobile Contract Cleaners will speak on the Charlotte region's best management practices for capture and containment of wash water and disposal of collected wash water. Representatives from Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and Charlotte-Mecklenburg Utilities will be on hand to discuss current regulations, enforcement and to answer questions.

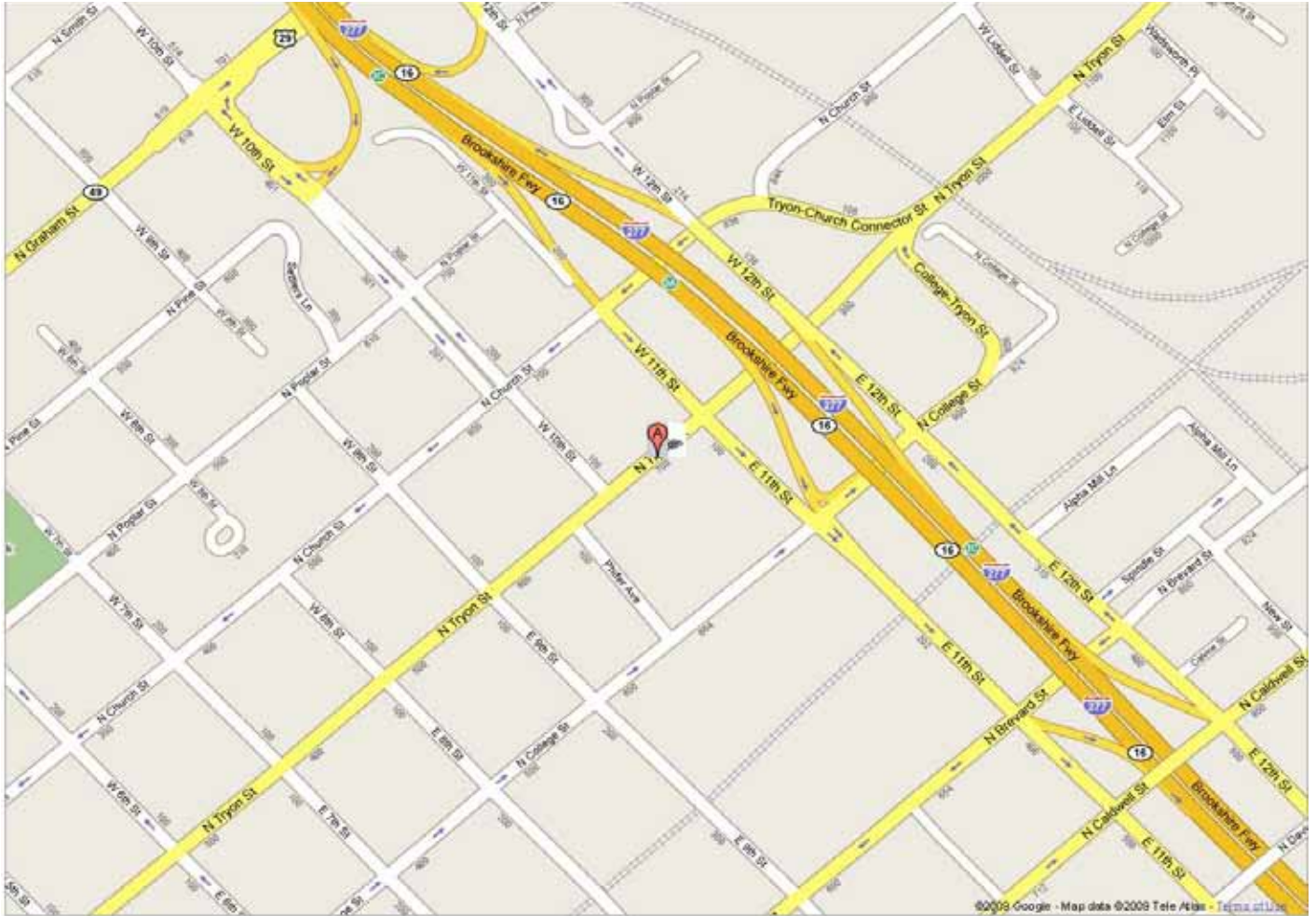
